- Paper, cardboard, tissues
- Grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, spray-free garden waste
- Wood ash from fireplace, straw and wood shavings

What we DON'T recommend:

- Meat
- Human or animal waste
- Sprayed garden waste
- Weeds
- Cooked food (it encourages pests)
