

Mother Nature is a great painter and our natural environment has inspired so many of Resene's most popular colours.

Next time you're out for a walk, pay attention to the colours around you, the colour combinations and the variety of tones. Nature is never just one colour, so why choose just one for your decorating? Build in tone-on-tone and layer multiple shades of the same and complementary Resene colours to reflect the subtle nuances of our natural world. WOOD IS GOOD

Wooden floorboards and furniture go well with a nature-inspired interior. Native timbers are fantastic but you can paint or finish any wood to create the look you require.
