

Create your own colour scheme

Roof

The roof may be an important part of your colour scheme. Remember the roof is the most exposed to the elements so choose a durable colour to keep it looking its best for longer. Resene Summit Roof (satin) or Resene Hi-Glo (gloss) is ideal. See the Resene Roof systems colour chart for colour ideas. Consider using a Resene CoolColour to minimise heat buildup.



Family II

Weatherboards

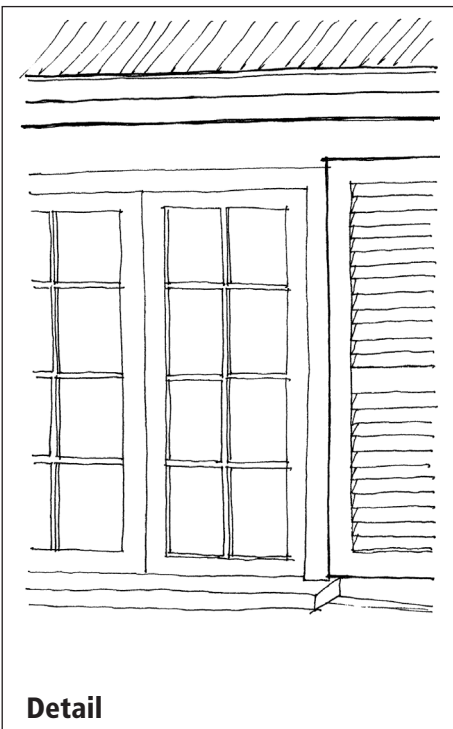
Usually this style of house is predominantly painted white, but a light pastel or off-white also looks good. Use Resene Hi-Glo (gloss), Resene Sonyx 101 (semi-gloss) or Resene Lumbersider (satin).

Windows and doors

Windows generally look best white or the same colour as the weatherboards. Use Resene Enamacryl (gloss waterborne enamel), Resene Lustacryl (semi-gloss waterborne enamel) or Resene SpaceCote Low Sheen (waterborne enamel).

Trim

Timber shutters, bargeboards and windowsills may be painted a darker colour to add contrast.
