



Create this striking vibrant abstract painting using two strongly contrasting Resene colours.

Resene art with Mark Rayner – 58

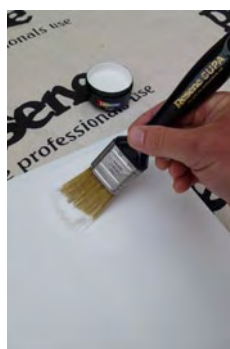
You will need:

- Artists' canvas
- Low tack masking tape
- Paintbrushes (including a medium artists' brush)
- Pencil
- Resene Quick Dry
- Resene testpots of Resene Alabaster and Resene Black
- Ruler



Step one

Apply one coat of Resene Quick Dry to the canvas and allow two hours to dry.



Step two

Apply two coats of Resene Alabaster to the canvas, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



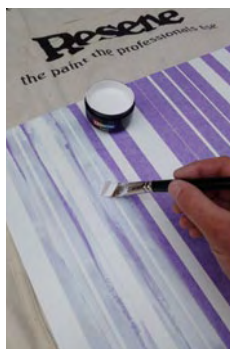
Step three

Using a ruler and pencil to ensure lines are parallel, mask off a series of random stripes across the canvas using low tack masking tape.



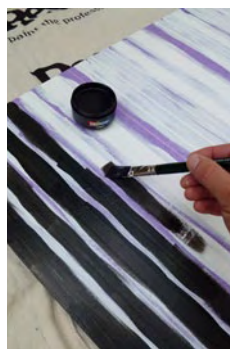
Step four

Continue until the canvas is completely covered with masked lines.



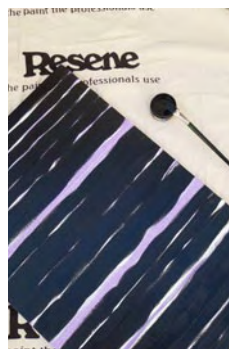
Step five

Apply a line of Resene Alabaster to the edges of the masked lines, as shown and allow to dry. This will prevent the darker colour from bleeding through later on.



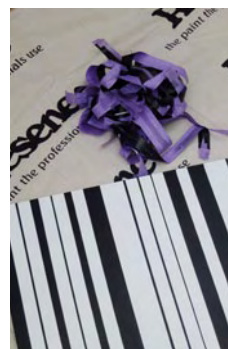
Step six

Apply one coat of Resene Black to the masked off stripes, as shown, and allow two hours to dry.



Step seven

Apply a second coat of Resene Black to the masked off stripes.



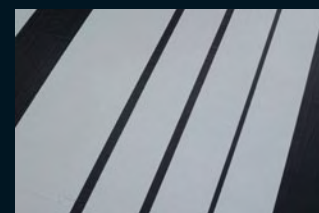
Step eight

Before the second coat has dried, carefully remove the masking tape. Allow to dry for two hours.



To get the look:

Mark painted the background wall with Resene SpaceCote Flat tinted to Resene Galliano.



Other ideas:

Try a rich pink combination painting stripes of Resene Glamour Puss over a background of Resene Soft Pink.
