You will need:

- Paintbrush
- Paint stirrer
- Resene Waterborne Woodsman penetrating wood stain tinted to Resene Touch Wood
- Sandpaper

• Treated timber planter



Step one

Smooth any rough edges on the planter with coarse sandpaper.



Step two

Wipe away any sanding dust with a clean, dry paintbrush.



Step three

Carefully stir the Resene Woodsman with a paint stirrer.



Step four

Turn the planter upside down and apply one coat of Resene Woodsman to the base.



Step five

Turn the planter the right way up and apply one coat of Resene Woodsman to the inside.



Step six

Apply one coat of Resene Woodsman to the outer sides of the planter.



Step seven

Apply one coat of Resene Woodsman to the top rim of the planter. Leave to dry for 24 hours.



Step eight

Apply a second coat of Resene Woodsman to the entire planter and allow to dry for 24 hours.

Exterior

Transform and protect a humble wooden planter using Resene Woodsman waterborne penetrating wood stain.



To get the look:

Mark painted the wooden raised bed with Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Woodstock.



Other ideas:

To create a dark contemporary effect stain the planter with Resene Woodsman tinted to Resene Pitch Black.
